# APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO AQUINAS COLLEGE

## CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

The conditions for admission are that the student abides by the College rules, that he participates in College activities and that he has the ability to benefit from the educational program offered by Aquinas College.

## MAJOR INTAKE YEARS

The Junior School: Kindergarten, Year 4 and all other years as numbers allow.

The Secondary School: Year 7 and all other years as numbers allow.

Boarding Students: Year 7 and all other years as numbers allow. It is always worthwhile to contact the College to enquire about places in later years.

**In the case of admission to the boarding school, enrolments are accepted for secondary years only.**

## APPLICATIONS

Applications may be lodged at any time but making an early application increases the likelihood of securing a place.

## REGISTRATION FEE

A Registration Fee is to accompany this Application for Admission form. The current Fees and Charges information is available on the College website under the Enrolments tab. The Registration Fee is **non-refundable**.

## SCHOOL REPORT

Parents will be asked to produce a current report for their son when they are interviewed for possible acceptance into the College.

## CHANGE OF ADDRESS / ENTRY YEAR

Notification of change of address or cancellation of an application must be made to the College **in writing**. If a parent wishes to change an application to an earlier or later year, this must be done **in writing**. Every consideration will be given to the request, but it is important that the year for which admission is sought in the first place should be thought out as carefully as possible before an application is made. Other commitments may make it impossible to arrange a change to an earlier or later year.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

The first stage of the enrolment process involves the completion and return of this Application for Admission form, accompanied by the Registration Fee and photocopies of the prospective student's Birth and Baptism Certificates. If the prospective student was not born in Australia, please provide proof of his Australian Citizenship/Residency or Visa details.

Siblings do not automatically gain entry to the College; this procedure must be followed for each boy in the family wishing to attend.

Approximately two years prior to the year of entry, parents will be contacted by the College regarding the next stage of the process.

## ENROLMENT CRITERIA

The College is often not able to accept all students for whom application is made, and the following criteria are used to select those students to whom an Offer is made:

- Sons of Catholic families.
- All offers considered on the basis of date of application and at the discretion of the Headmaster.
- Families who have a connection with Aquinas College as either a father, grandfather or having had brothers at the College.
- Students from interstate or overseas who have been attending an Edmund Rice School.
- Siblings of students already enrolled at Aquinas College.
