TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Lottery permit

The Aquinas College Ladies Auxiliary June Morning Tea Tuition Raffle (**Raffle**) is being conducted pursuant to lottery permit LS210098217 [issued by the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor].

The Permit is held by Peter Robertson to conduct and promote the Lottery in Western Australia.

Lottery Permit Holder: Peter Robertson, Dean of Development, Aquinas College

The Raffle is a fundraising initiative and all proceeds raised will be used for the Arts and Culture Program at Aquinas College.

Promotion Period

- **Raffle begins:** Thursday 1 June 2017 9.00AM AWST.
- **Final ticket sales close:** Thursday 30 June 2017 10.30AM AWST (unless sold out prior to this time)
- **Draw date:** Thursday 30 June 2017 at Aquinas College at 11.15AM AWST.
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Terms and Conditions

- Purchasers must be 18 years or older.
- Only 800 tickets at \$50 each will be sold.
- There is no limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased by each individual Purchaser (subject to the overall ticket limit of 800).
- No person is permitted to participate in the lottery until the whole purchase price of the ticket has been paid.
- Proceeds from the sale of the Raffle tickets will go towards the Arts and Culture Program at Aquinas College.
- The winner will be notified in writing and the names of the winner may be published on the Aquinas College website and in the Aquinian issued Term 3 Week 1.
- Aquinas College may use a prizewinner's details for promotional purposes. By purchasing a Raffle ticket, the Purchaser agrees that if the Purchaser is a prizewinner, the Purchaser will participate in reasonable media activities concerning the Raffle draw and to photographs or video of the winner being used for Aquinas College's marketing and promotional activities (both in print and on the internet).
- The Raffle draw is subject to a minimum number of tickets being sold, as determined by Aquinas College. If the required minimum number of tickets is not sold by the closing date, the Raffle will be cancelled and monies refunded to Purchaser (less Trybooking fees), subject to the approval of and any conditions imposed by the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA.

Main Draw

- Assuming all tickets are sold, each ticket has a 1 in 800 chance of winning the prize.
- The prize value is \$17,037 in Tuition Fees only.
- The sum of \$17,037 (Tuition Fees) will be credited to the 2017 account of the winner's choosing. The account must be that of a student attending Aquinas College in 2017.

Unused portions can be carried over a maximum of 3 years for the same student provided the student is attending Aquinas College.

- The prize must be redeemed within 12 months of the draw date (by Friday 29 June 2018) by notifying Mr Peter Shaw, Dean of Business and Finance Aquinas College of the winner's intention to redeem the prize.
- Unused balances cannot be redeemed for cash and are not refundable in any portion.
- If the winner so chooses, the prize may be donated to the Aquinas College Ladies Auxiliary to be allocated at the Aquinas College Ladies Auxiliary discretion.
- The prize is not transferable or redeemable in cash.
- Tickets are not transferrable.
- In the event enrolment ceases prior to the full value been applied, strictly no refunds will apply.
- The prize will be applied to tuition fees only of the nominated student. Costs incurred by optional co curricular activities and levies are not included in the annual tuition fee.

Conduct of Draw

The prize draw will be conducted by a representative of the Aquinas College Ladies Auxiliary at the June Morning Tea to be held at Aquinas College, 58 Mount Henry Road, Salter Point 6152 by means of a barrel draw.

The winner will be notified by telephone or email and their name will be published in the Aquinian Week 1 Term 3 and on the Aquinas College website. The decision of the President Ladies Auxiliary (or delegate) will be final and binding.

Unclaimed prizes will be dealt with in accordance with the procedures set out in the Gaming and Wagering Commission Act 1987 (WA).

Refunds: Refunds can only be processed prior to the date of the prize draw. Requests for refunds will need written approval of the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA. This process may take a number of weeks. Refunds cannot be issued after the prize draws.

Changes: Where it is lawful to do so, these Terms and Conditions may be updated to address any errors or to clarify information and re-published online at www.community.aquinas.wa.edu.au or otherwise as required by the requirements of the Permit or the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA.

Excluded purchasers: the Lottery Permit Holder must not purchase tickets. Excluded purchasers will not be entitled to collect the prize.
